

Requirements to Renew a Five-year Credential

- Applications for renewal may be made between January 1 and August 31 of the renewal year.
- Complete at least six (6) semester credits during the validity period of the credential.
- At least three (3) of the semester credits must be taken for college or university credit.
- Idaho district/charter school/private school in-service hours may be applied toward up to three (3) credits. Must submit signed *Idaho District/Charter School/Private School Approved In-Service Verification of Completion Form*

Requirements for One or Three-year Credential

- Specific requirements are listed as conditions in the bottom half of this credential.
- Interim Certificates are valid for three (3) years and are non-renewable. The conditions listed must be met to qualify for a five-year credential.
- For authorizations issued for one (1) year, conditions must be met to qualify for a revision.
- The State Board of Education Provisional Certificate is valid for one (1) year, does not have conditions and is non-renewable.
